



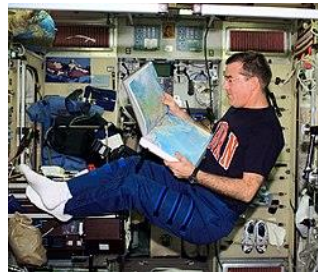
## Be Like an Astronaut Sensory Box Activity

### Materials:

- Book
- Large box or container
- Items that astronauts will need in space (tools, Velcro, vacuum-sealed food, juice pouch, gloves)
- Items that astronauts would study in space (different types of rocks, plants, book)
